Students must submit two letters of reference attesting to their character and ability. These references may accompany the application or follow under separate cover.

Students are expected to be sensitive to local dress code and customs of East Africa and act in a responsible manner.

Since we will be traveling and living together as a group, any behavior that would disrupt the program, infringe on the enjoyment of the program by other students, or compromise the safety of others will not be tolerated. Students who do not act in an appropriate manner will be asked to leave the program and will be asked to return home.

Successful applicants will be required to read and sign a document outlining appropriate behavior if they wish to participate in the program
